The training programme at this level lasts 5 years.

Prior to the acquisition of the title, it is necessary to have an experience of at least 3 years, as it is regulated by the statute of APCGC.

The requirements for continuing the professional development are not mandatory. APCGC has a partnership with the Technical University of Constructions regarding the possibility for its members to continue their professional qualification by doing post-universitary courses.

APCGC organized together with the Romanian Union of Geodesy and the Faculty of Geodesy national symposiums and conferences in the fields of cadastre and land measurements.

The Romanian Association of Private Surveyors allows, under the statutory provisions the professionals with an academic level as members associates. The technicians can become only affiliate members.
