- It is a search for a domain model that can be used for a LA system that can support all forms of land rights
- Focus on 'people land' relationships
- Built with 'Free and Open Source' software
- Motivation: urgent need for rights recognition and improved tenure security
- Impreciseness has to be accepted: insisting on expensive standards is not in the benefit of the poor and government as well
- Specialization of the FIG Land Administration Domain Model basis of ISO 19152.






Social Tenure Relationship





- facilitate recording all forms of land rights, all types of rights holders and all kinds land and property objects / spatial units regardless of the level of formality











STDM spatial unit
