History of the FIG Foundation

The FIG Education Foundation was established in 1996 as a public company under the Corporation Laws of Australia.

In 2000 the administration of the FIG Education Foundation was transferred to the FIG permanent office in Copenhagen.

The General Assembly of FIG adopted the new Statutes for the FIG Foundation at its meeting in Seoul 11 May 2001.

At the same time the original FIG Education Foundation was closed and the new FIG Foundation officially opened under the FIG umbrella.

Distribution of FIG Foundation Grants 2011-2014


