

LADM Edition II

Steps are needed to operationalise the Land Administration Domain Model. The Open Geospatial Consortium initiated such development and there is a cooperation with the International Standardisation Organisation in this respect. This development requires, apart from attention to data models, also attention to process models for support to data maintenance and transactions in land administration. If this could be included in a new edition of LADM there would be a standardised basis for development of services. Processes and transactions are outside the scope of the LADM Edition I from 2012. The reason that processes are outside the scope of LADM I is that processes were considered to be country specific when LADM I was prepared. Generic processes would be too difficult to model. This view needs reconsideration – given developments as Fit-For-Purpose Land Administration, Apps and blockchain. This will be an issue in the development of LADM Edition II.
